Observations and measures Q1 2024

Discussed by the management group on 22 May 2024

Observations	Corrective measure
 The service production for accident prevention is behind the planned realisation rate in terms of safety points and the regular fire inspections of primary sites. The reason for this is the lack of resources in the service production due to high staff turnover. Regular fire inspections (primary sites): In Q1/2024, 90.4% of the target was realised. Safety points: In Q1/2024, 94.1% of the target was realised. 	We will remedy the lack of resources as soon as possible. We will develop measures for proactive recruitment.
Rescue operations still do not achieve all of the target times set for operational readiness (previously made observation still valid).	The detailed corrective measures are recorded in the monitoring report of 2023. The City of Helsinki Rescue Services have submitted a first report on the matter regarding the fulfilment of the primary obligation (report from 2022). Based on the review, the first part of the primary obligation was fulfilled as required, and the Regional State Administrative Agency will not impose the first part of the fine. The City of Helsinki Rescue Services have submitted a second report on the matter regarding the fulfilment of the primary obligation (report from 2023). As for this, a review will be carried out in the beginning of 2025.
