4. Rental of premises, vehicles, personnel and equipment

Premises, vehicles, personnel and equipment are only rented out to cooperation authorities and partners.

5. Grounds for compensation for an alarm entitling to compensation

If the Western Uusimaa Wellbeing Services County has the right to receive compensation, for the operations of the Rescue Department on the basis of an alarm caused by an intentional act or negligence or on another basis, and unless the amount of compensation has been otherwise provided for, the required compensation will be determined on the basis of the activity carried out and the unit prices in this table of fees.

6. Fixed price or other basis for payment

A fixed price or other payment basis can be agreed with the client for training events and security guards, in which case the rescue director confirms the price.

7. Appeals

With regard to statutory fees (sections 1–3), appeals are filed in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act (434/2003).

In the case of No-statutory fees (sections 4–5), you can apply for the payment basis in section 6 by addressing the application to the Rescue Director.

The payment under section 5 can be adjusted in accordance with the provisions on damages in the Tort Liability Act (412/1974)
